

SEVEN DEAD IN BOMBER CRASH NEAR ST. LOUIS

ST. LOUIS, Dec. 16—(AP)—An Army bomber carried seven men to death as it crashed and burned last night a few minutes after taking off from Lambert-St. Louis airport. Two others escaped. A list of dead was released by the Topeka, Kas., air base today.

The plane burst into flames and set fire to the farm house of Mr. and Mrs. Reginald Crouse.

Mrs. Crouse bundled her two-months-old daughter, Barbara, in a quilt and escaped from the burning house.
