

Bomber Crash Kills Seven

ST. LOUIS, Dec. 16—An Army bomber carried seven men to their deaths as it crashed and burned last night a few minutes after taking off from Lambert-St. Louis

Airport. Two others escaped, including Sergt. Harwell Clements, 858 Neff Road, Grosse Pointe, Mich., who suffered a small cut over his left eye.

No Michigan men were among those killed.

The plane grazed the roof of a barn before it nosed to the ground, burst into flames and set fire to the farm house of Mr. and Mrs. Reginald Crouse.
